

Warranty Procedures – Canada

EFFECTIVE: June 1, 2007

Montreal Hockey takes pride in providing a quality and exceptional product produced with Nano Hyptonite Epoxy. We strive to provide the consumer a highly durable product; however, materials are subject to possible break down over time; therefore we do provide a 60 day warranty on all Nitro Lite composite sticks and 30 days on all Force and Max composite sticks.

Warranty conditions are as follows:

- 1) The shaft or stick must have been purchased from an authorized Montreal Hockey dealer in the last 30 days for Force or Max and 60 days on Lite
- 2) The consumer must have their original proof of purchase.
- 3) The shaft or stick must be returned in its entirety.
- 4) The breakage is a result of a manufacturing defect.
- 5) Replacement is limited to a one time replacement. Montreal Hockey reserves the right to substitute of similar or higher value.

Note: This warranty does not apply to Pro, Junior, College or Rep team sales of blades or composite goalie sticks

Damage due to the following will not be covered by warranty:

- 1) The damage occurs in abusive game action, contact with another player, skate cut, goal post or rink boards.
- 2) The blade is exposed to any type of open flame or heat source
- 3) The blade is altered by any means including filing, sandpapering or rasping.
